

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

As the challenge continues brought by the Covid-19 pandemic, mining and mineral processing plants in the Province of Palawan continue in providing support and assistance to their partner-communities. As of 08 July 2020, the total combined budget amounting to **PhP 60,911,289.32** is allocated from the approved realigned SDMP funds and the Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) of the mining and mineral processing plants in the province. Of the total amount allocated, as part of their CSR, Coral Bay Nickel Corporation (CBNC) and Rio Tuba Nickel Mining Corporation (RTNMC) allocated PhP6,050,000.00 intended for the purchase of rice and assorted goods that was distributed to the number of target household/families of the Municipality of Bataraza.

To date, ninety-eight percent (98%) or a total of **PhP 59,907,563.12** of the realigned SDMP and CSR funds were utilized benefiting a total of 141,056 households/families, 1400 employees, and 1523 front liners.

For **July 02-08, 2020**, a total amount of **PhP6,000,000.00** was spent from the CSR of RTNMC and CBNC for the continuous implementation of initiatives that benefitted **23000 households/families** of the Municipality of Bataraza, Palawan.

Issues Encountered*

Name of Program/Activity : **Social Development and Management Program**

- Resistance of some mining communities, barangay officials, in extending assistance to the Province of Palawan.

- Some barangay official/s insists on providing cash instead of food packs or in-kind relief.

- Difficulty on the observance of social distancing during information dissemination and relief distribution.

- Difficulty in procuring/sourcing and outsourcing of supplies and materials (rice, food packs, etc.)

- Due to the lockdown, RTNMC and CBNC cannot participate (documentation will be impossible) in the distribution of relief/assistance provided to the Province of Palawan.

- Restricted movement, general population may go out of their homes only for purposes of accessing basic necessities

- Public transportation operates at a reduced capacity
